

1. All prices indicated in this document list whether they are inclusive or exclusive of GST.
2. NZIBS registration for the conference is through the NZIBS website [www.buildingsurveyors.co.nz](http://www.buildingsurveyors.co.nz). Credit card processing fees are applicable otherwise select the online banking which does not apply a surcharge.
3. For a large group of registrations from one company, please send a list of names, email addresses, dietary requirements and conference activities you would like to register them for to [christina@buildingsurveyors.co.nz](mailto:christina@buildingsurveyors.co.nz) before the deadlines listed below.
4. To be eligible for the NZIBS Member registration rate, you need to be a current NZIBS Registered, Transitional, Retired or a Student member.
